All seats reserved and will be distantly assigned by the TN Theatre. No refunds. No exchanges.

ATTENDANCE

ALL CLASSES AND EXTRA REHEARSALS MARCH 22 UNTIL PERFORMANCE DAY ARE MANDATORY

- classes that meet once weekly are allowed one miss, classes that meet twice weekly are allowed two misses.
- all rehearsals at the theatre (May 6 & 7) cannot be used as a miss. Dancers *cannot miss* the tech rehearsal.
- if quarantined, dancer must Zoom the rehearsals. Only two Zoom rehearsals will be allowed. Zoom may only be used for quarantined dancers. All rehearsals must be attended in person.

**TECH
REHEARSAL**

Friday, May 7 TECH Rehearsals at the Tennessee Theatre-mandatory

- Each class will have a 10 minute staging rehearsal. Refer to "Tech Schedule" for arrival and pick up times.
- Dancers must arrive at scheduled time. Drop off at the stage door on Clinch Avenue.
- Parents will not be allowed in the theatre for techs.
- Pick up dancer at scheduled time at the front doors of the TN Theatre (under the marquis).
- Please have dancer dressed in first costume, performance hair. Carry additional costumes on coat hangers, neatly and thoroughly labeled. Dancers with a costume change must have a nude camisole leotard.

TICKETS

The Tennessee Theatre is allowing SAFD to have 300 audience members. All live attendees will be required to wear a mask.

Dancers with the last name A - I may purchase up to 5 tickets to the Saturday performance.

Dancers with the last name J - Z may purchase up to 5 tickets to the Sunday performance.

You will receive a Docu-Sign document to reserve/purchase your tickets. If you wish to purchase additional tickets, a waiting list will be started (check the box on your Docu-sign to get on the waiting list).

The deadline for ticket purchases/reservations is April 15. The Tennessee Theatre will assign distanced seating assignments for each family. SAFD will have no control over seating assignments. You are unable to select your seat. You may pick up your tickets from our office the week of May 3 - 5. We will have an outside table set up for ticket pick up (weather permitting).

VIRTUAL

THE SATURDAY PERFORMANCE ONLY WILL BE LIVE STREAMED FOR VIRTUAL VIEWING. The live stream will be available via VEEPS, a ticketing and live stream platform. Those who wish to livestream can purchase a \$10 ticket on Veeps (plus service fees) and gain access to the show. (They will need to create a VEEPS account). The performance will stay on Veeps for viewing until May 24, 2021.

COSTUMES

- All ballet dancers must have clean ballet shoes with straps sewn on. No holes in shoes allowed.
- Tights must be clean without runs.
- All costume items must be labeled with dancer's name on them: tights, shoes, headpieces, etc.
- If in more than one dance, arrive in first costume with other costumes on individually labeled coat hangers.
- All dancers that have a costume change *must wear a nude colored leotard under all costumes.*
- No garment bags.
- Place ballet shoes, tights and headpieces in zip lock bag attached to hanger (label everything!)
- Hair nets must be worn for all buns.

DROP OFF INFORMATION

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY PERFORMANCES

- Drop your dancer off at the security door, 204 Clinch Avenue. If parking, park in the State Street Garage.
- When dropping off your dancer at the security door, no street shoes should be worn into the theatre
- Age 5 through level II: no dance bags, backpacks, tablets or electronics allowed backstage.
- Any phones or electronics are brought at your own risk. Leave them home if possible for safe keeping.

MATINEE RELEASE PROCEDURE

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE PERFORMANCE:

- **SATURDAY:** Age 5 dancers will be released from the stage immediately after the performance. Dancers age 6,7 - Level I -Level II with the last name A - I will be released from the stage one dancer at a time in alphabetical order. Dancers with the last name J - Z will be taken downstairs to wait for parent pick up at the theatre side entrance.
- **SUNDAY:** Dancers age 6,7 - Level I -Level II with the last name J - Z will be released from the stage one dancer at a time in alphabetical order. Dancers with the last name A - I will be taken downstairs to wait for parent pick up at the theatre side entrance.

SNACKS/FOOD

TECH REHEARSALS ON FRIDAY

- Have your dancer bring bottled water and light snacks. While the dancers will be waiting in the house of the theatre, they will change downstairs in the dressing rooms and have an opportunity to eat a quick snack if they need.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY PERFORMANCES

- Pack light snacks for backstage (fruit, cheese, sandwiches, juice boxes, water.)
- No lunchboxes-please place all snacks in paper bag labeled with dancer's name and title of dance(s).
- NO PEANUT BUTTER PRODUCTS
- Clear drinks only.

VIDEOS/PHOTOGRAPHY

- No videotaping or flash photography is allowed during the performances. We encourage you to purchase a DVD.
